

MARAÚ PENINSULA - BAHIA

Situated between the Dende and Cocoa Coasts and between the main cities of Ilhéus and Salvador, the Maraú Peninsula is an environmental protection area with lush flora and fauna of rich biodiversity. With over 40km of semi- deserted beaches, Taipu de Fora beach, with its natural pools, is considered one of the most beautiful in Brazil. The landscape is completely transformed with the variation of the moon and the tides where dozens of natural pools form during low tide, with plenty of fish and marine life that arise in coral reefs. Not only by the beaches people are attracted to Maraú, but also by its freshwater lakes, rainforests, mangrove protected areas (the largest in Brazil) and by the small villages. Barra Grande is the largest village of the peninsula, but still preserves the simplicity of the local population.



DAY 1 – July 13th, Sunday – IN/ ILHÉUS – MARAÚ PENÍNSULA (LAGOA DO CASSANGE)

Arrival at Ilhéus Airport and transfer to Pousada Lagoa do Cassange, Maraú Peninsula (112km, approximately 3 hours). Check-in and rest of the day free to relax. Overnight in your bungalow.

DAY 2 TO 4 – July 14th to 16th – PENÍNSULA MARAÚ (LAGOS DO CASSANGE) – (B)

À la carte breakfast can be served in your bungalow or at the restaurant (at your choice). During your stay at Pousada do Cassange the following are included, and the schedule will be decided locally according to weather conditions and the tide.

Eco-social tour (3-4 hours)

go on this eco-social tour and get to know the local community. Visit the Maramar School Project (www.projetomaramar.org.br), where you will learn more about this non-profit organization idealized to educate to promote a social transformation. Also enjoy a short boat ride through the mangrove.

Taipu de Fora Natural Pool (4 hours)

Depart on a 4WD vehicle passing through coconut trees, the Bromeliads Garden, open fields and native bush until we reach the Natural Pool on Taipu Beach. That's the perfect place to go snorkeling or free



diving as the visibility of the water is exceptional. You will have time to enjoy yourself and have a drink and snacks (not included) on the beach. Return to the Pousada.

Note: there are snorkeling equipment for rental at the beach, however we recommend taking your own.

Camamu Bay of Islands & Tremembé Waterfall (7-8 hours)

Leave from Port Jobel by boat on Rio do Céu (Sky River). You will visit fishing villages such as Taipu de Dentro, Sapinho and Campinho, several secluded beaches and the Pedra Furada Island, where the rocks have naturally formed an arch covered in native bush. Navigate to the Goió Island, the perfect stop for a swim. Next stop is Sapinho Island where lunch (not included) will be served based on fresh and local produce. After lunch, head south of the bay to visit the Tremembé Waterfall, descending from the rainforest straight to the salty water. It is possible to get under the fall on the speedboat and walk the way up to bathe in the natural pools. Return to the Pousada by sunset.

Note: the order of the places visited may change according to tide.

DAY 5 – July 17th, Thursday – MARAÚ PENÍNSULA - ILHÉUS / OUT (B)

At the appropriate time, check-out and transfer in a private vehicle to the airport. Fly to your next destination. End of services.



OPTIONAL TOURS DESCRIPTION (not included)

Walking tour Mata Fome & Vila do Tanque (4 hours)

Leave from the Jobel Port by boat and enjoy the beautiful colors of the mangroves, as you go up Rio do Céu (Sky River). Disembark on an island and begin your Mata Fome walk on an easy trail (1 ½ hour) until you reach Vila do Tanque. Walk past through bucolic landscapes, small houses and village (where there are no cars) and have amazing views of the Camamu Bay. It's possible to go for a swim if you wish. On Maraú River port, take the boat back to Rio do Céu and continue by canoes up the Cassange River (20 minutes). Get off for a short walk (5 minutes) on a mangrove until you meet the car that will take you back to the Pousada.

Barra Grande & Ponta do Mutá (4 ½ hours)

In the afternoon be driven to the extreme north of the peninsula until you reach the last beach on open sea – Praia dos Três Coqueiros. From there, start walking on the beach passing through the lighthouse of Ponta do Mutá, he exact point of entrance of the Camamu Bay. After a 40-minute walk, you will get to Barra Grande, a great beach to relax and swim in the tranquil waters and watch the sunset. You can also go for a walk on the small and quiet village. **Note:** the order of the stops may change due to the tide of the day.



Algodões Beach Walk (4 hours)

Depart by car until Saquaira beach (4km). Begin walking on the beach for 1 hour until Algodões Beach, where, on low tide, the sea is flat in a perfect condition to go for a swim. And after you can dip in the Aibim freshwater. On the way back to the Pousada, stop at the Saquaira village to taste some of the homemade sweets, such as pies, ice-creams and cocadas (sweets made of coconut).
